Half Day City & Table Mountain Tour

The tour takes you along the Atlantic Seaboard to Hout Bay (optional seal island boat trip - weather permitting; not included), via Chapman's Peak to Cape Point, Simon's Town & the Boulders Beach Penguin Colony and ends with a visit to Kirstenbosch National Botanical Gardens. *Note: The drive via Chapman's Peak is subject to the road being open. Ou Kaapse Weg will be used as an alternative route when necessary.*

Full Day Cape Riviera & Whales

August to November is usually the best time to see the Southern Right Whale in our waters. Walker Bay's Hermanus is an ideal place for whale watching.

Depart Cape Town via Elgin – heart of the apple industry – en route to Hermanus. Visit the Old Harbour Museum. Enjoy a wine tasting at the Hamilton Russell Vineyards (not included in cost). Visit the Harold Porter Botanical Gardens and return to Cape Town via the coastal route which offers wondrous views of the False Bay coastline. *Note: This tour is offered on a private basis only.*

Full Day Boat Based Whale Watching

Depart Cape Town and travel to Kleinbaai. The boat trip takes you to Dyer Island, Geysers Rock, and the world renowned Shark Alley. See various bird species including the African Penguin, a 60'000 strong seal colony, Great White sharks, Bryde's whales, Humpback whales and dolphins. Return to shore and enjoy a warm drink while watching a DVD of your day before returning to Cape Town.

Note: This activity is strictly weather permitting. Self Drive – boat departure times 09h15, 11h15, 11h45 and 14h15 (arrival 1 hour before departure time)

Morning transfer to the Atlantis sand dune. You will then receive a safety briefing. After your sand boarding experience, break for lunch (packed) before the quad biking begins.

Your exclusive trip will take you over the 'Republic of Hout Bay' and give you a magnificent view of Seal Island. Continue over the heart stopping curves of Chapman's Peak and the extensive lagoon laced stretches of Noordhoek beach and inland through Sun Valley to the fishing village of Fish Hoek, along Muizenberg and past the lush Constantia Valley.

Depart Cape Town and travel to Kleinbaai. Enjoy a continental breakfast before the boat launch around 08h30. The anchor is lowered, the cage goes into the water, a scent trail is made, final preparations for the diving are made and the rest of the day is spent watching, diving and enjoying the day. Also visit Dyer Island, depending on the tide and sea conditions. After about 3 to 4 hours, head back to land.

This is followed by a tasting before continuing to Franschhoek - the culinary capital of the Cape. It is therefore only fitting that we enjoy lunch here after the second wine tasting of the day at Haute Cabriere. Cycling Cape of Good Hope

The reserve is home to an array of fynbos, over 250 species of birds, buck, baboons and Cape mountain zebra. Enjoy the views from the Cape Point Lighthouse before visiting the penguins at Boulders Beach. Time & tide permitting, enjoy an afternoon swim on a semi-private beach before returning to your hotel.

Full Day Constantia Wine Tour

Constantia is the birthplace of the wine farming industry in South Africa. Located just 20 minutes outside of Cape Town's city bowl, it is breathtakingly beautiful, with vineyard rows that stretch up the eastern slopes of the Constantiaberg mountainside. As you drive through this historical valley, it becomes apparent why the first Governor of the Cape, Simon van der Stel, chose this situation for his farm, Constantia. The route is an easy day trip and the farms provide quality restaurants for lunches and tea.

Sea Kayaking & Cape Point Tour

There is no better way to experience the False Bay coastline other than a morning sea kayaking experience. Paddle past the civilian and Naval Harbour of Simon's Town and out to Boulders Beach. The double kayaks are very stable and perfect for those with no paddling experience. After visiting the penguins you stop (time & tide permitting) on a lovely semi-private beach for refreshments, swimming and snorkeling (equipment provided). The latter part of the day sees you visiting the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve and Cape Point, then on via Chapman's Peak Drive to Hout Bay and ending at your hotel in the late afternoon.

Hiking Table Mountain & City Tour

The walk begins at the upper cable station and traverses the entire front table to Maclears Beacon – the highest point at 1087m. The walk returns via a different route providing a variety of vistas. The entire walk takes about 2 hours. *Note: If the cable car is not operational on the day, and depending on clients' fitness levels, the walk would be adapted accordingly.* After lunch (to own account), explore the history, architecture and culture which makes Cape Town the colourful and vibrant city it is today. Visit the Malay Quarter, Company Gardens, The SA Museum and the Castle of Good Hope.
